



Resolution on ASEAN Centre of Excellence For Sports Coaching : Roundtable Convention On Sports Coaching 2025

We, the **Roundtable Convention on Sports Coaching delegates**, assembled in **Putrajaya, Malaysia from 13th to 15th May 2025**, call upon **ASEAN Leaders** to support the decision made during **ASEAN SOMS-13 on 26th October 2022** in the establishment of the **ASEAN Centre of Excellence (COE) for Sports Coaching in Malaysia** under the **ASEAN Work Plan for Sports 2021-2025**.

We hereby urge the ASEAN Member States to:

- 1. Strengthen/establish a national coaching entity** to enhance the development of sports coaching, leadership, education, and overall youth well-being. These organisations will serve as centralised hubs for training, accreditation, and innovation in coaching, fostering a unified regional approach to excellence in sports development.
- 2. Leverage the ASEAN COE for Sports Coaching** as the central knowledge hub for sharing, developing, and standardising best practices in sports coaching across ASEAN.
- 3. Encourage ASEAN Member States** to consider aligning their national coaching frameworks with international best practices, integrating innovative methodologies to enhance youth and professional coaching development.
- 4. Strengthen regional cooperation** through the ASEAN COE for Sports Coaching to improve coaching standard, enhance professional development opportunities, and foster an inclusive coaching ecosystem.

5. **Encourage experts from the ASEAN** Member States to share expertise, best practices, and coaching innovations with international organisations and relevant entities in strengthening its role in the global sporting landscape.

6. **Establish a dedicated ASEAN working group** aligned with ICCE (International Council for Coaching Excellence) to advance coaching development and collaboration across ASEAN Member States.

7. **Initiate engagement** with International Olympic Committee Solidarity regarding ASEAN COE for Sports Coaching future development plan, ensuring alignment with global coaching initiatives.

8. **Encourage the host of SEA Games** to set-up a Coach House in future SEA Games with the aim of promoting knowledge exchange and experience sharing during the Games.

9. **Advocate for full support** of all ASEAN COE for Sports Coaching events to foster continuous engagement and development opportunities for coaching professionals.

10. **Support the ASEAN COE for Sports Coaching** effort to provide educational resources, professional advice, and global communication through ICCE channels and events, strengthening international collaboration.

We call upon ASEAN Leaders to fully support the initiatives **by the ASEAN COE For Sports Coaching** in ensuring its success as a **strategic driver** for sports development, coaching professionalism, and youth empowerment across ASEAN.
