



## JAGUH RAKAN MUDA TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### A. BASIC TERMS

2	<b>Name of Competition</b>	Jaguh Rakan Muda
3	<b>Brief Description of Competition</b>	<p><b>Jaguh Rakan Muda</b> is an exciting reality competition that brings together youths aged 13 to not more than 30 years old on a transformative journey that tests their physical strength, mental resilience, emotional endurance, and leadership skills.</p> <p>The competition kicks off in <b>Episode 1</b> with <b>80 participants</b>, each facing a series of individual challenges designed to push their limits in strength, strategy, agility, determination, and leadership.</p> <p>From <b>Episodes 2 to 6</b>, the top <b>40 contestants</b> are divided into <b>five teams</b>. Each team elects a captain through a democratic process, putting their judgment and decision-making skills to the test.</p> <p>As the season unfolds, teams compete in high-stakes challenges. The team with the lowest score in each round faces elimination. By the <b>finale</b>, the remaining teams battle it out for the ultimate title: <b>Jaguh Rakan Muda Champion</b>.</p>
4	<b>Brief mechanism of Competition</b>	<p>A brief outline of the Competition mechanism:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. On-Ground Audition <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) On-Ground Auditions will be held at 5 zones – Central, North, East Coast, Sabah &amp; Sarawak. Each Participant is required to register by completing and submitting the official Registration Form, which will be provided at the registration counter (on-site) to the Organiser.</li> <li>(b) The 80 shortlisted Participants will be selected by the judges and advance to the Challenge Rounds.</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. The On-Ground Audition Stage will have two (2) stations: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Station 1: Each Participant is required to fulfil the physical strength challenges. Each Participant's performance will be evaluated by a panel of judges appointed by the Organiser.</li> <li>(b) Station 2: Each Participant is required to fulfil the intellectual challenges. Each Participant's performance will be evaluated by a panel of judges appointed by the Organiser.</li> <li>(c) Station 3: Each Participant must record a video of themselves showcasing their desire to participate in the Competition and the talents they bring to the table, which must be related to the <i>10 Gaya Hidup Rakan Muda</i>.</li> </ol> </li> <li>3. Participants in Station 1, Station 2 and Station 3 will be assessed in accordance with the following scoring criteria:</li> </ol>

- (a) Physical Strength and Endurance
- (b) Mental Agility and Problem-Solving Skills
- (c) Passion and Personality

4. A total of 80 Participants will be shortlisted from the On-Ground Audition Stage and will advance to the Challenges Rounds. ("**Shortlisted Participants**").

**Challenge Rounds**

Shortlisted Participants will compete in the following Challenge Rounds:

**1. Challenge 1**

The 80 Shortlisted Participants will be grouped into 4 categories according to their age and gender, as outlined below:

- **Teenage Boys:** 13 to 17 years old
- **Teenage Girls:** 13 to 17 years old
- **Adult Men:** 18 to not more than 30 years old
- **Adult Women:** 18 to not more than 30 years old

Shortlisted Participants will be required to complete both physical and intellectual challenges individually. Scores will be adjusted according to the respective categories. At the end of Challenge 1, only 40 Shortlisted Participants will be selected to advance to the next stage.

Judging Criteria

- (a) Physical Performance
- (b) Intellectual Performance
- (c) Adaptability and Resilience
- (d) Effort and Determination
- (e) Overall Potential

**2. Challenge 2**

The 40 chosen Shortlisted Participants will elect 5 team captains through voting. Each team captain will then choose 7 teammates from the remaining Shortlisted Participants to form their teams. The first challenge will be to build a boat. Each teams must construct a boat using designated eco-friendly materials, and the boat must successfully cross the river. Each team's performance will be evaluated by the appointed judges. The team with the lowest score will be eliminated, while the rest will advance to the next stage.

Judging Criteria:

- (a) Boat Construction Skills – Durability and functionality of the boat
- (b) Design Creativity – Visual concept and artistic impact
- (c) Team Spirit and Cheers – Enthusiasm and coordination demonstrated through a unique team song or chant
- (d) Race Speed – Fastest time to cross the finish line

**3. Challenge 3**

Only 4 teams will advance to Challenge 3. These 4 teams will be tasked with building a house for the Orang Asli community while overcoming challenges to secure construction materials. The teams must also produce a 1-minute video highlighting a community issue and a call to action for CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) support. Their performance will be evaluated by the appointed judges. The team with the lowest score will be eliminated, while the rest will advance to the next stage.

Judging Criteria:

- (a) Teamwork – Collaboration, coordination, and effectiveness in working together

		<p>(b) Design Creativity – Originality and innovation in the house design</p> <p>(c) House Construction Skills – Quality, durability, and functionality of the completed house</p> <p>(d) Presentation &amp; Communication - Clarity, passion, and impact of their 1-minute video or any final presentation, including the strength of their call to action for CSR.</p> <p><b>4. Grand Final</b> Only the remaining 3 teams will compete in the Grand Final.</p> <p><b>(i) Round 1</b> The final 3 teams will face an extreme race-style relay challenge. Each team member must complete an individual task. The team that completes the course in the fastest time, or demonstrates the best overall performance, will win the challenge. Their performance will be evaluated by the appointed judges. The team with the lowest score will be eliminated, while the rest will advance to the next round.</p> <p>Preliminary challenges include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Extreme Physical Challenge – Tests of physical endurance</li> <li>• Extreme Mental Challenge – Puzzle-solving tasks</li> </ul> <p><b>(ii) Round 2</b> The final 2 remaining teams will advance to a final team challenge designed to test their strength, endurance, creativity, and strategy. Each team must discuss and vote to assign members to specific tasks (physical, mental, or combined). The team that demonstrates the greatest speed, intelligence, and unity will be crowned the Champion.</p> <p><u>Judging Criteria:</u></p> <p>(a) Speed and Completion Time</p> <p>(b) Team Strategy and Role Allocation</p> <p>(c) Creativity and Problem-Solving Skills</p> <p>(d) Endurance and Strength</p> <p>(e) Teamwork and Unity</p> <p>All Participants MUST comply with the Competition’s structure, as briefed and communicated by the Organiser during the Competition Period.</p>
5	<b>Eligibility Criteria</b>	<p>1) The Competition is open to all Malaysian citizens between 13 to not more than 30 years old as at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025. For avoidance of doubt, please refer Age of Eligibility below.</p> <p>2) Participants must be Malaysian citizens, permanent residents, and holders of a valid visa, and must possess valid Malaysian National Registration Identity Cards (NRIC) and/or passport.</p> <p>3) Participants must not have been convicted of any criminal offense as of the date of application, nor be currently under investigation or facing any charges for any criminal offences (road traffic offenses exempted).</p> <p>4) Participants must not have been declared bankrupt within the preceding six (6) years or be currently involved in any bankruptcy proceedings as of the date of application.</p>
6	<b>Ineligibility</b>	<p>1. Any individual who does not meet the eligibility requirements outlined in the Eligibility Criteria section will be deemed ineligible to participate in the Competition.</p>

		<p>2. Employees of the Organiser, the Producer, and their respective subsidiaries and affiliated companies, as well as their <i>immediate family members</i>.</p> <p>3. Employees of the official sponsors of the Competition, and their immediate family members.</p> <p>4. Immediate family members of the judges involved in the Competition.</p> <p><i>Immediate family members shall mean spouse, children, parents, brothers, and sisters (inclusive of adoptive family members).</i></p>
7	<b>Age of Eligibility</b>	<p>1. The Competition is open to all Malaysians who are between thirteen (13) to not more than thirty (30) years old, meaning not below thirteen (13) and not exceeding thirty (30) years old as at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025. Individuals born before or after this window are not eligible to participate in the Competition.</p> <p>2. Participants under the age of 18 years old must obtain the consent of his/her parent or legal guardian to be eligible to participate in the Competition and to receive the Prize. The Organiser considers it the responsibility of parents and/or legal guardians to monitor their children's participation in this Competition.</p>
8	<b>Competition Period</b>	<p><i>The Competition will be held from 9 August 2025 to 15 November 2025.</i></p> <p>The Organiser reserves the right to amend, postpone or re-schedule the Competition Period or any of the dates thereof at its sole discretion.</p>
9	<b>Language of Competition</b>	<p>The Competition will be organised and produced by the Organiser in Bahasa Melayu and English. All Participants must be able to converse comfortably in [either language / both languages].</p>
10	<b>Entry Procedure</b>	<p>All candidates are required to attend the on-ground auditions.</p> <p>Invitations may also be extended to potential candidates scouted by the Organiser, however all such potential candidates are required to attend the standard on-ground auditions with the other candidates as well.</p> <p>Participants must fill in the application form provided at the registration counter during the on-ground audition day.</p> <p>The Organiser shall be entitled to request to sight the original Identity Card or the originals of other supporting documents/materials for verification purposes.</p>
11	<b>Entry Deadline</b>	<p>Entries must be received by the Organiser during the audition day, before the registration counter is closed.</p> <p>Entries received before the commencement of the Competition Period and after the stipulated Entry Deadline will be disqualified and ineligible for participation.</p>
12	<b>Mode</b>	<p><b>1. Audition:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Participants are required to participate in the On-Ground Audition, where they must physically attend the audition event as set forth by the Organiser. Participants must present their valid Malaysian National Registration Identity Card (NRIC) as proof of citizenship.</li> </ul> <p><b>2. Challenge Rounds</b></p>

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All Participants are required to be physically present on the designated date for the Challenge Rounds. Failure to attend any stage of the Challenge Rounds may result in disqualification or ineligibility for that round of the Competition. The Organiser retains the right to adjust the dates, and relevant Participants will be informed of any changes.</li> </ul>
13	<b>Address</b>	At the specific location to be advised by the Organiser
14	<b>Selection of Winner</b>	Winners will be selected based on the format of the Competition.
15	<b>Prize</b>	Champion Team: Cash Prize One Hundred Thousand Ringgit Malaysia (RM 100,000) to be shared amongst members of the Champion Team
16	<b>Notification of winners</b>	The winner will be announced by the Organiser at the end of the Grand Final.
17	<b>Collection Period</b>	Within three (3) months from the notification by the Organiser
18	<b>Collection Venue</b>	All Asia Broadcast Centre, Technology Park Malaysia, Lebuhraya Puchong-Sungai Besi, Bukit Jalil, 57000 Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.  or any venue to be advised by the Organiser.
19	<b>Additional Terms, if any</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Selected Participants <u>must</u> participate in all segments of the Competition. No substitution or replacement of any of the Participants is permitted at any time during the Competition. In the case of any emergencies or unavoidable or unforeseen circumstances, the Organiser in its sole and absolute discretion may allow a Participant to exit from the Competition.</li> <li>Where a Participant is selected to participate in the Competition, such Participant must be able to take time off from their daily activities at a time that is required by the Organiser at its sole discretion.</li> <li>During the Competition Period, Participants are not allowed to participate in any other form of other gameshow or competition, whether similar in substance, elements and/or format to the Competition or otherwise, save with the Organiser's prior written consent.</li> <li>Participants must be free from any contractual obligation / arrangement or any other legal encumbrance, which may prevent him/her from participating in this Competition.</li> <li>The Organiser reserves the right to change the format and/or mechanism of the Competition at any time during the Competition Period at its sole discretion.</li> </ol>

The Competition Basic Terms and Conditions ("Basic Terms"), the Competition Standard Terms and Conditions (collectively "**Terms and Conditions**") and the Privacy Notice shall be binding on all contestants who participate in this Competition ("**Participants**"). The definitions in the Competition Standard Terms and Conditions shall apply unless otherwise expressly agreed in the Competition Basic Terms and Conditions. In the event of any inconsistency between the Competition Standard Terms and Conditions, the Competition Basic Terms and Conditions and the Privacy Notice, the Competition Basic Terms and Conditions shall prevail to the extent of such inconsistency.
